1. Explain the obligations of a vessel “restricted in her ability to manoeuvre” when meeting a vessel not under command.

2. A vessel less than 12m in length is operating at night. What lights are they permitted to display instead of full navigation lights?

3. What are the sound signals for a vessel not under command in restricted visibility?

4. Describe the action required when a power-driven vessel overtakes another in a narrow channel.

5. You observe two sailing vessels approaching each other with the wind on opposite sides. Which one shall keep out of the way?

6. Under Rule 9, what are the duties of a vessel less than 20m in length when navigating in a narrow channel?

7. Explain the “special circumstances” mentioned in Rule 2(b). Give one example.

8. A vessel is engaged in dredging and displays two black balls in a vertical line on the port side and two black diamonds on the starboard side. What does this indicate?

9. In restricted visibility, which rule governs vessel conduct and what is its main requirement?

10. Under Rule 18, rank the following vessels in order of priority:

- Vessel constrained by draught
- Fishing vessel engaged in fishing
- Vessel not under command
- Power-driven vessel underway
